

INFORMATION ABOUT ROHS – COMPLIANCY OF EOZ PRODUCTS

To whom it may concern

Dear Sir

RoHS, or to use its accurate but somewhat lengthy title "Directive 2002/95/EC replaced by 2011/65/EU on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment", has been enforced throughout the European Community from 1st July 2006.

Its aim is simple - to restrict the use of six substances (lead, mercury, cadmium, hexavalent chromium, brominated flame retardants: PBB and PBDE) within electrical and electronic equipment (EEE), thereby contributing to the protection of human health and the environment.

Although RoHS is a European Union (EU) Directive, manufacturers of EEE outside Europe must also comply with this legislation if the equipment they produce is ultimately imported into a EU member state.

The EOZ company is glad to confirm that all our products are compliant to the above EU directive.

The compliancy of the product is indicated on the packaging either by text or by paper sticker 'RoHS compliant'.
